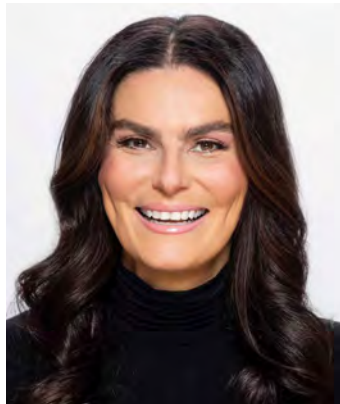

This year, we solidified our role as a leader in Jewish advocacy, achieving unprecedented success in combating antisemitism. Through our dedicated efforts, hundreds of individuals were held accountable for their antisemitic actions—losing their jobs, while several others faced serious legal consequences, including arrests and prosecutions. In addition to our grassroots and digital advocacy, we've made significant strides in legislative arenas. From participating in congressional hearings to derailing the nomination of an antisemitic judicial nominee, we tirelessly championed stronger protections against antisemitism and elevated the urgency of this fight to the forefront of public discourse.

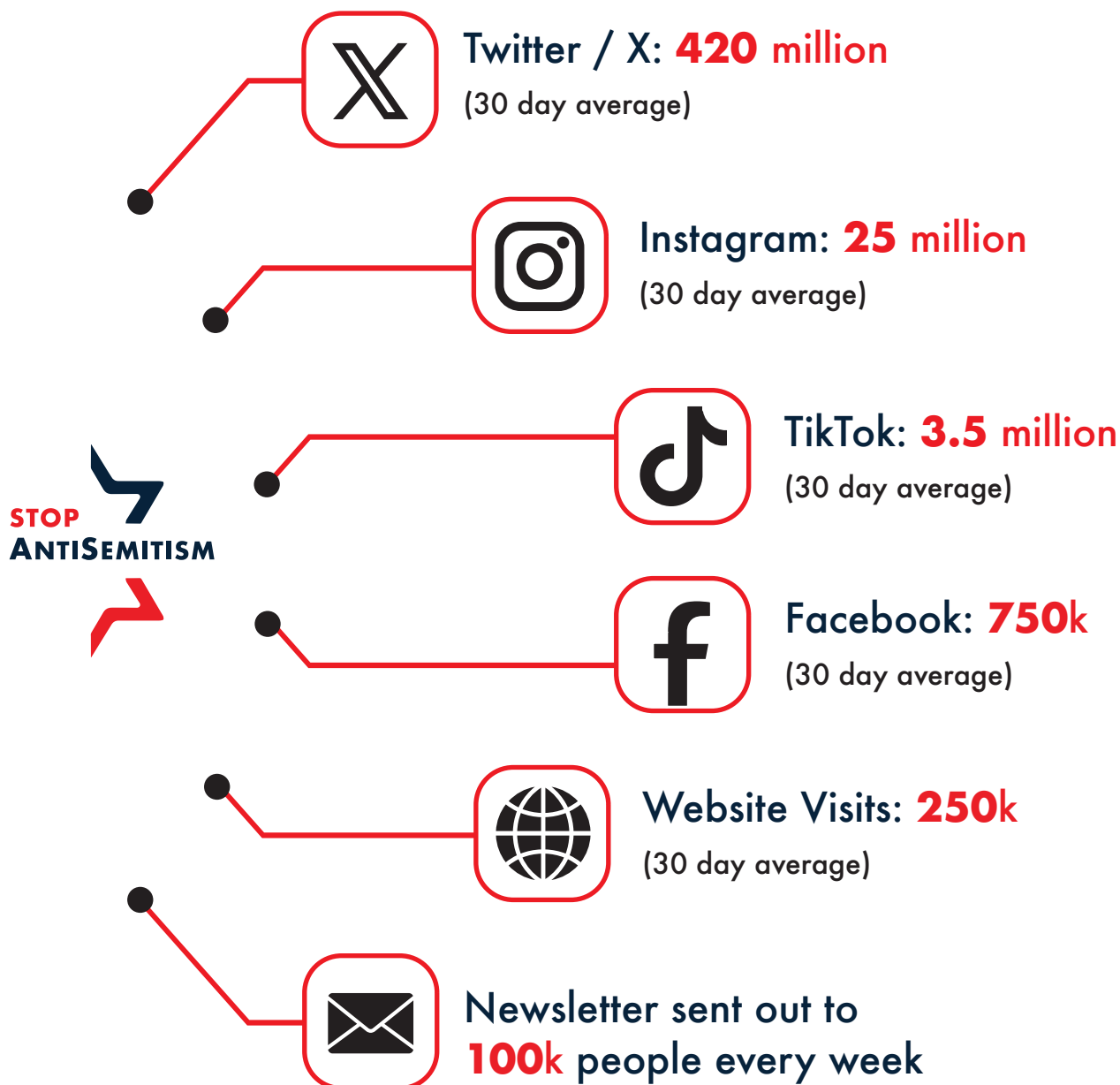

STOP ANTISEMITISM | PROCESS

StopAntisemitism serves as a resource to anyone who wants to stand up against hate. There are multiple ways in which people can report incidents of antisemitism 24/7, including our website and social media channels.


Once an incident is reported, StopAntisemitism mobilizes. Depending on the situation, this includes but is not limited to:

- Gathering all information around the circumstances to create a meaningful call to action.
- Vetting all relevant details for accuracy and ensuring that all the facts of the incident are consistent before any action is taken.
- Liaising with law enforcement.
- Reaching out to the educational institution of which the perpetrator is a member or notifying the perpetrator’s place of employment.
- Engaging press and exposing the information on social media.

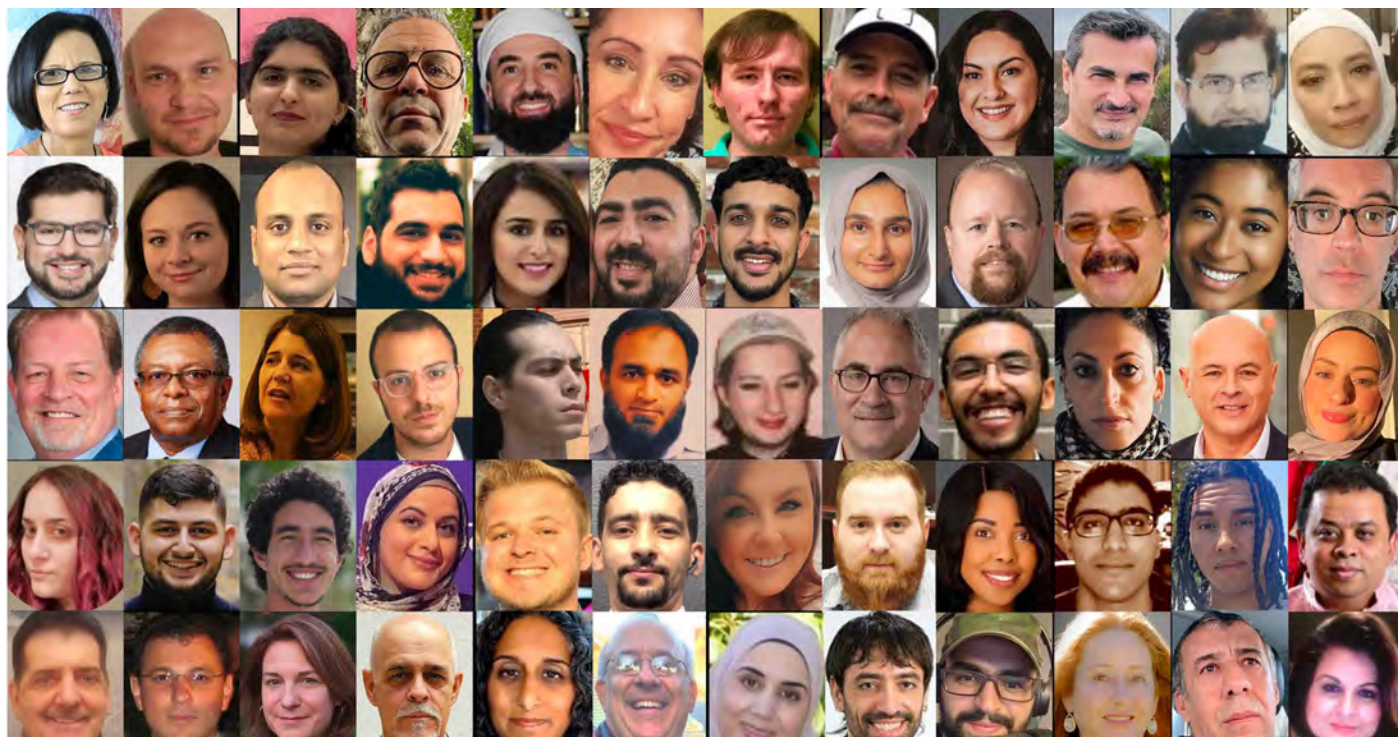

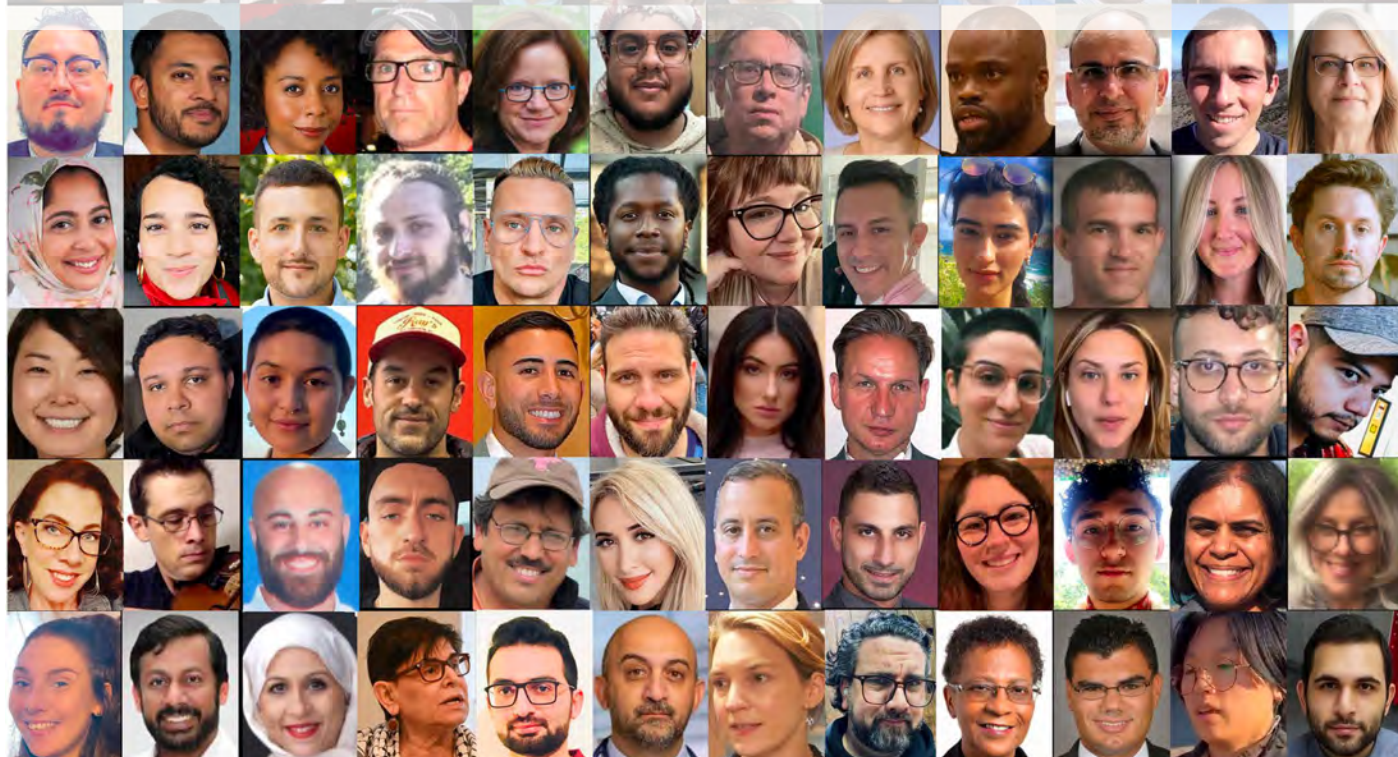

STOP ANTISEMITISM | ADVOCACY

In 2024, StopAntisemitism has been relentless in delivering results to protect Jewish safety and hold antisemites accountable. We helped block an antisemitic judicial nominee, made a powerful impact at the NYC Israel Parade, and led the charge in Washington, D.C., on the October 7th anniversary. Our actions are forcing real consequences for Jew-hatred and ensuring the fight against antisemitism remains front and center.

StopAntisemitism Blocks Antisemitic Judicial Nominee

StopAntisemitism helped prevent Adeel Abdullah Mangi's confirmation to the Third Circuit Court of Appeals. From 2019 to 2023, Mangi advised the antisemitic Center for Security, Race and Rights (CSRR), which hosted convicted 9/11 terror supporter Sami al-Arian. Working with the Senate Judiciary Committee and Senator Ted Cruz, StopAntisemitism exposed Mangi's extremist ties, ensuring his rejection.

NYC Israel Parade: A Powerful Statement

At the NYC Israel Parade, StopAntisemitism's massive billboard truck demanded the return of Israeli hostages, reaching over 50,000 attendees. As the parade celebrated Jewish pride, our presence kept the fight against antisemitism front and center, sparking vital conversations and mobilizing support.

10/7 Anniversary: Demanding Justice in D.C.

On the first anniversary of the October 7th attacks, Liora Rez stood in Washington, D.C., alongside partner organizations and Vice President Vance, demanding justice and the return of Israeli hostages. Her speech highlighted the victims' suffering and reinforced StopAntisemitism's commitment to holding perpetrators accountable and ensuring Jewish security.






NEW INITIATIVE: STOPDONTSHOP



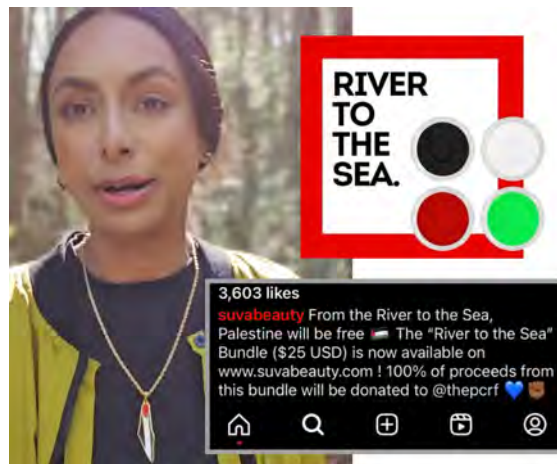
In direct response to the horrifying events of October 7, 2023, StopAntisemitism launched **StopDontShop** to spotlight businesses taking a stand for Israel and to expose those targeting the Jewish community or supporting terrorism against them. Debuting on social platforms like Instagram and X in late November 2024, the initiative has gained tremendous traction, and we're going full speed ahead.

The campaign's centerpiece is an interactive website that categorizes businesses across industries such as fashion, tech, entertainment, legal, medical, and retail. Users can explore and filter businesses by rating, location, and category:

- 
◦ **StopDontShop** (RED): Businesses that support Hamas and/or espouse hatred toward the Jewish people and nation.
- 
◦ **Caution** (YELLOW): Businesses requiring clarity on their perceived or real positions regarding the Israel-Hamas war.
- 
◦ **Shop** (GREEN): Businesses that have taken a clear stand against terrorism and shown unwavering support for the Jewish people and nation.

2024 COLLEGE REPORT | SUMMARY



In the wake of our **2024 Antisemitism on U.S. College & University Campuses Report**, StopAntisemitism has been inundated with alarming accounts of rising antisemitic harassment, threats, and exclusion on campuses across the country.

Since the October 7th massacre, submissions from Jewish students have surged by an astonishing **3000%**, highlighting the growing vulnerability of Jewish students and the systemic failure of universities to protect them.

The findings are deeply troubling:

- **55%** of Jewish students report experiencing antisemitism.
- **43%** don't feel safe enough to report incidents, and of those who do, **87%** say schools failed to act.
- **43%** hide their Jewish identity out of fear.
- **72%** feel unwelcome in certain spaces simply for being Jewish.
- **67%** say Jews are excluded from DEI initiatives.
- **69%** are unfairly blamed for the actions of Israel.
- **43%** wouldn't recommend their school to other Jewish students.

Only two out of 25 universities responded to our survey, underscoring a pervasive lack of leadership in addressing antisemitism. Most schools fail to include antisemitism in DEI frameworks, leaving Jewish students feeling unwelcome and unsafe. However, a few institutions have made proactive strides, setting an example for others to follow.

It is imperative for all universities to adopt the IHRA working definition of antisemitism, integrate antisemitism into DEI training, establish Jewish affinity groups, and take decisive action against harassment. The current landscape demands immediate and meaningful change to ensure campuses are safe and inclusive for Jewish students and all others.

2024 ANTISEMITE OF THE YEAR | CANDACE OWENS

In an unprecedented year of voting, **Candace Owens** was crowned Antisemite of the Year after over 30,000 votes were cast—an unfortunate but fitting title for someone who has spent countless months revealing her deep-seated antisemitism, culminating in her departure from Ben Shapiro's *Daily Wire*.

Candace Owens' track record of antisemitism is both long and deeply troubling. She defended Kanye West's hateful remarks about Jews, mocked the legitimate fears of Jewish individuals, and even liked social media posts referencing dangerous blood libels—going as far as to claim that Jews hunted Christians during Passover. Her penchant for spreading wild conspiracies includes accusations that Israel controls Hollywood, orchestrated 9/11, and is behind ISIS.

Her rhetoric has also veered into Holocaust denial, as she suggested that Dr. Mengele's horrific experiments on Jewish prisoners were mere "propaganda" and falsely alleged that Israel was established as a haven for pedophiles. Owens further escalated her hate by claiming that Israel "took over" America and threatening violence against anyone who referred to the nation as an ally.

White supremacist Nick Fuentes praised Owens as the "face of Jewish defeat," highlighting her alignment with some of the worst antisemitic narratives. Her hateful views were so appalling that even conservative allies like Dennis Prager and Ben Shapiro publicly condemned her. Evangelical groups, her own father-in-law Sir Michael Farmer, and entire countries like New Zealand and Australia also rebuked her, though Owens blames her disgrace on a supposed "Zionist media empire."

Candace Owens' hateful rhetoric has solidified her as a voice of antisemitism, and her win as Antisemite of the Year is a stark reminder of her grim legacy.
